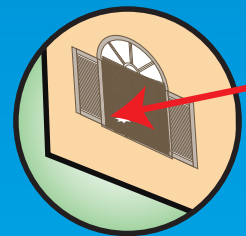

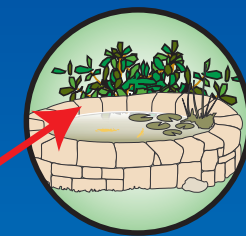

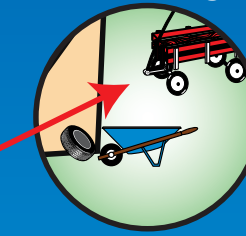

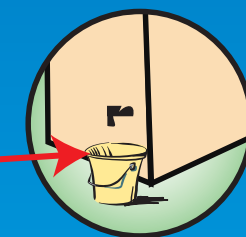

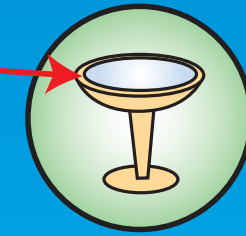
Poorly maintained pond
