- 5. Towns voted out: Lancaster, Boylston, Grafton. The activity of the Reclamation Board and the Central Mass. Mosquito Control were very badly discredited and liabled by one Mr. Ted Williams who handled the truth very carelessly
- 5a. We must come up with some sort of a plan whereby these towns could re-enter the project if they resigned.
- 6. Jack Evangelous resigned effective 5/11/90. He will be missed very much. David will make his recommendation to the Commissioners at the next meeting for a replacement of General Foreman or maybe we will fly without one for awhile.
- 7. Doing special events mosquito control with with Mist Blowers. Expect to start Monday through Thursday nights with ULV machines for adult mosquito control.
- 8. Our request for FY91 for budget was \$658,321.00. Due to three towns withdrawing, we will ask our representative and senators to reduce it to \$593,416.00.
- 9. The Wilmington FY90 funding matter seems to have been resolved by our Superintendent by having the check deposited with the Reclamation Board and paying a vendor directly.
- 10. At the next meeting we should get a list of prospective people we would recommend to the Reclamation Board for two Commissioners, one to replace Mrs. Anderson and one to replace Malcolm Henry who surprised us all by announcing that he is resigning effective October 1, 1990.

- 11. Letter to Reclamation Board attention of Mr. Costa not answered yet. Malcolm and David will check on this.
- 12. We are operating with 13 employees, 5 less than last year.
