- 1. The minutes of the preceding meeting of June 21, 1990 were unanimously approved.
- 2. The following payrolls were unanimously approved:

- 3. Invoices totaling \$429.96 were approved unanimously.
- 4. The schedule of once a week working in each town seems to be holding up; phone calls are down. Up to the month of July population was 27% higher in 1990 than in 1989.

Water management and larviciding continue in areas when environmental conditions permit.

- 5. No action on our FY91 Budget as yet.
- 6. Lancaster's meeting to reconsider re-entry into the project was unfavorable. Some adverse feeling that CMMCP didn't continue working in the town after they voted out.
- 7. Southborough Board of Health meeting worked out satisfactorily.
- 8. Lunenburg's meeting with Board of Health worked out okay.
- 9. Dracut has expressed interest in joining our project. Board of Selectmen and Town Manager will sanction the town joining. Commissioners feel it is okay to take Dracut into the project for a miminum of three years.
- 10. The Reclamation Board is setting up a task force in which David is a member in case we have an EE outbreak. The task force would be in place and have the necessary equipment and material available if needed.
- 11. Next meeting August 16, 1990.
