When rain and warm weather come we could have a real mosquito year; eggs are all in place waiting for Mother Nature to give the signal. Northeast Vector Management is checking the output of our machines for size of droplets. We could do it but best to have an independent company check it and tabulate the results.

We have 3 part time summer help to start June 1st.

5. Lunenburg Town Meeting, 4/11/92, voted to stay in project; however, this could come up under reconsideration.

6. A copy of the re-draft of Bill No. 2700 was given to each Commissioner; a bill with many changes. At this point after a quick scanning it looks like the bill has no funding.

7. Sherborn Board of Health requested a meeting Wednesday night which David will attend.

Town of Westford - no action on Article.

Town of Shirley Town Meeting 5/18/92 - Second Article is mosquito article to vote out; being second could be a blessing or homicide.

Stow has an Article to rejoin our project.

8. David showed a couple of videos on mosquito control. Some discussion given whether to spend \$3,000 to make a CMMCP video or not.
