

SURVEILLANCE:

Adult mosquito surveillance to monitor mosquito-borne diseases & document mosquito species and population densities.

PUBLIC EDUCATION:

Education to schools, civic groups, local and state officials about mosquito biology, program services, control techniques and personal protection methods.

DITCH MAINTENANCE:

Restoring drainage systems to historic conditions to allow the free flow of water, reducing larval mosquito development from that area.

LARVAL MOSQUITO CONTROL:

Surveys of wetlands to monitor the development of mosquito larvae and perform control techniques to minimize mosquito emergence.

ADULT MOSQUITO CONTROL:

Site specific applications to control mosquito adults and reduce risk from mosquito-borne diseases.

RESEARCH & EFFICACY:

To check for the efficacy of our products and techniques, and perform research in new or advanced control methods.

SOURCE REDUCTION:

Tire recycling to eliminate mosquito larval habitat and reduce risk from mosquito-borne diseases.

BEAVER MITIGATION:

Proper management of beaver populations to reduce potential negative aspects of beaver activity.
